



WATERBURY MAIN STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

SPRING 2020 INFORMATION SHEET

Project Overview

The Main Street project involves "full depth reconstruction" of Main Street, including replacement of all municipal water and sewer infrastructure, roadway, and streetscape amenities. The project also includes undergrounding of aerial utilities and new traffic signals in the business core of the downtown. New sidewalks, period lampposts, replacement trees and landscaping, informational kiosks, wayfinding signs, hanging flower baskets, and banners will enhance the entire downtown.

Project Area

The project will occur between the railroad bridge by the roundabout and continue for approximately one mile down Main Street to Demeritt Place. Utility work, storm drainage, and sidewalk improvements will take place on side streets within the project area.

Project Timeline

- Start Date: April 2019; End Date: July 2021
- 2019 work completed: storm drains, water, sewer lines in Segments 2-4; most underground conduits in Segments 2-3.
- 2020 work planned: same as above in Segment 1 including conduits on Stowe Street and work on Bidwell Lane.

- Come to the Public Information Meeting on March 17 at 6 pm in the Steele Community Room at the Municipal Complex. VTrans, J.A. McDonald (contractors), and town officials will provide an overview of the project and respond to questions.

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Anticipated Hours and Locations of Operation

- Beginning in mid-April 2020, construction will take place during the daylight hours, approximately 6:30 am to 6:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
- There will be approximately 20-30 nights of construction from 7:00 pm to 7:00 am at and around the intersection of Stowe Street and Main Street, as well as the Park Row intersection.
- Beginning in April 2020, construction is planned to start in Segment 2 behind the fire station and from Foundry Street to Bidwell Lane, and will then transition to Segment 1 and all other remaining work in each segment.
- The Main Street work zone is broken down into four segments. Segment 1 starts by the railroad bridge on North Main Street and Segment 4 ends a short distance past Demeritt Place on South Main Street. See map overview below for Segments and side streets.
- Different levels of construction will be taking place in all Segments throughout the season to complete the new curbs, sidewalks, roadway, and underground utilities.
- Street amenities, replacement trees, and landscaping are planned to be completed by July 2021.
