Survey Dates: Monday, January 6, 2020 - Friday, January 24, 2020

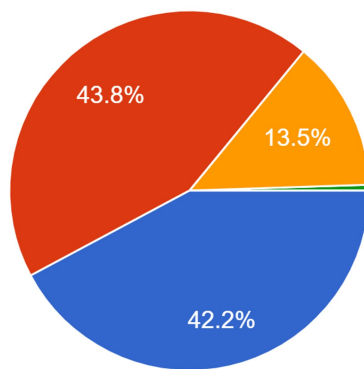
Total Respondents: 192

## Why do you travel through downtown Waterbury?

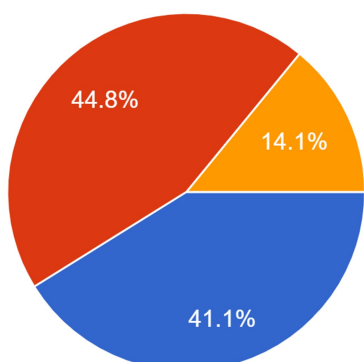
192 responses

## How would you rate the traffic control efforts (flaggers, signs, etc.) during the first year of the Main Street Reconstruction project?

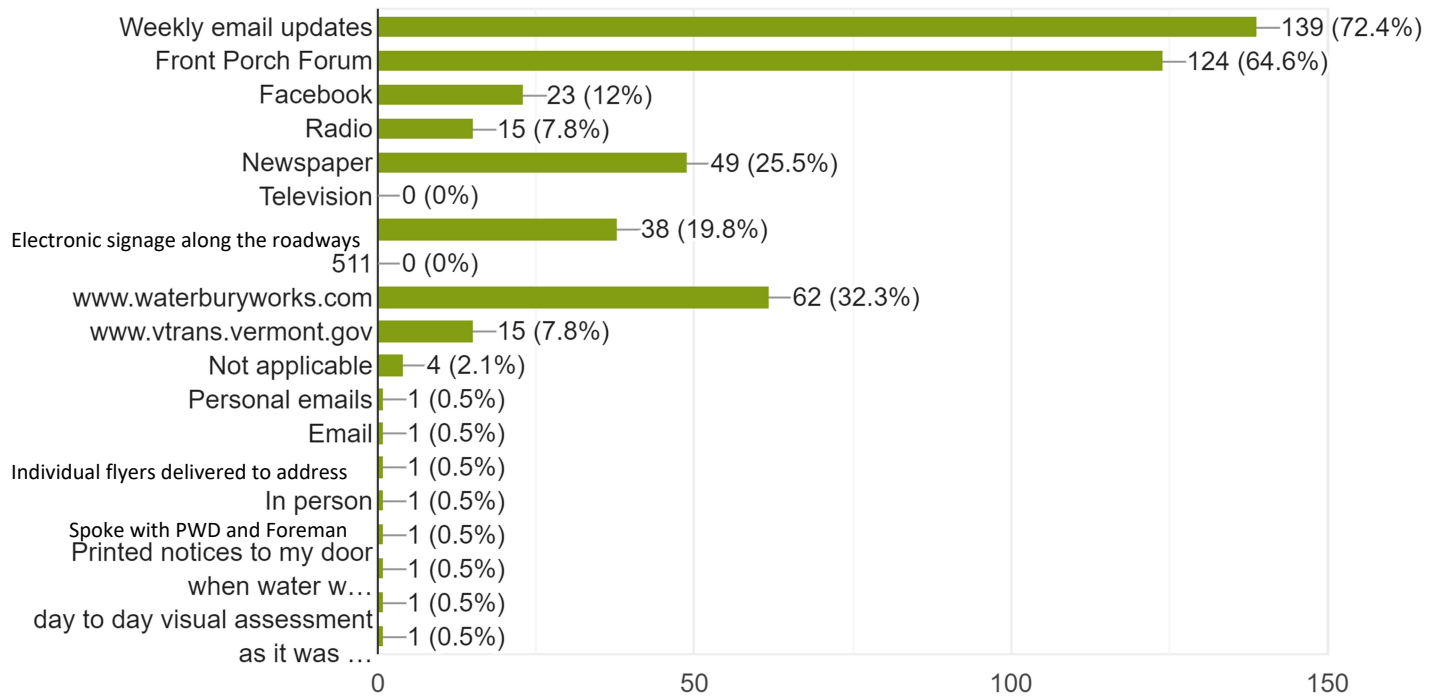

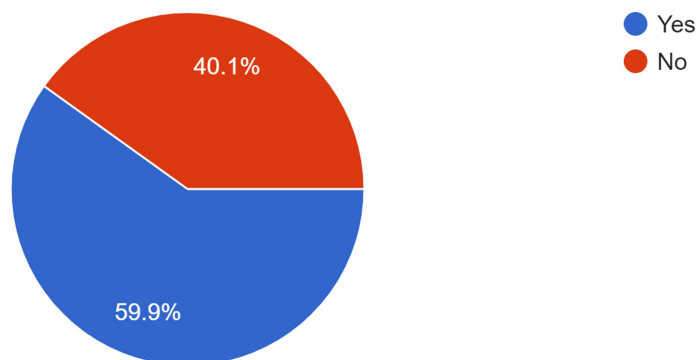

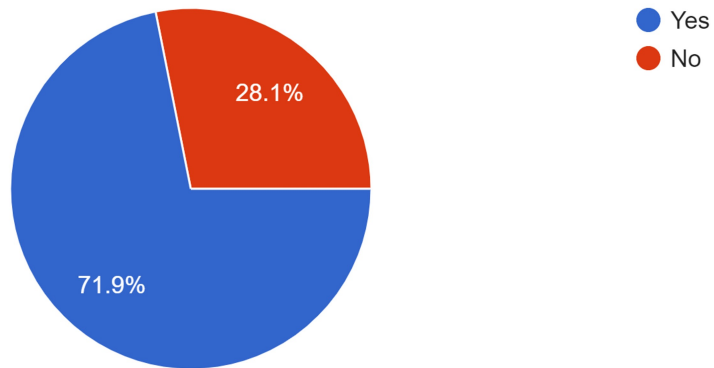
Did you sign up to receive updates for the Main Street Reconstruction project on WaterburyWorks.com?

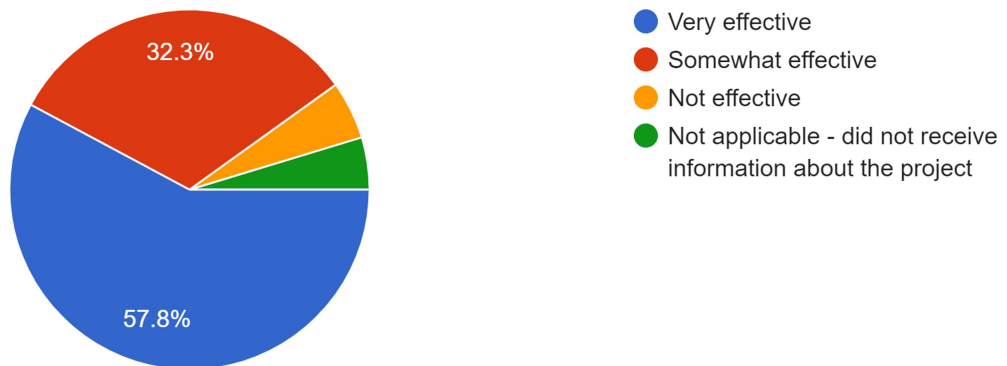
Did you receive individual email updates on the Main Street Reconstruction project?

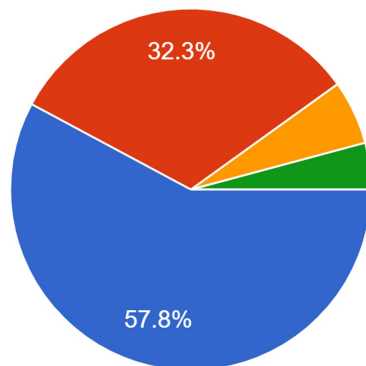
How effective was the project information communicated in advance of construction in preparing you for construction activities and traffic conditions?

How effective were the weekly updates in preparing you for construction activities and traffic conditions?

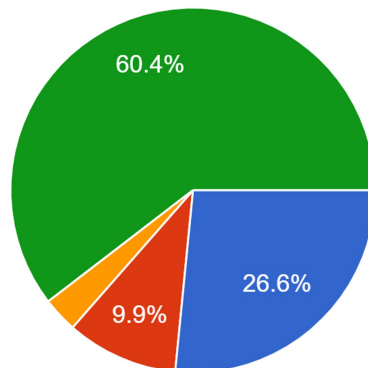

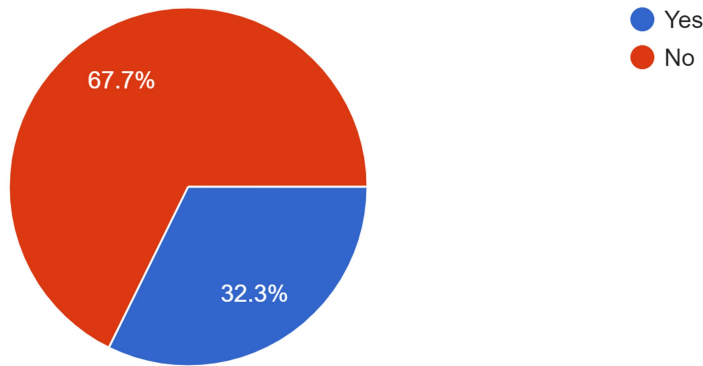

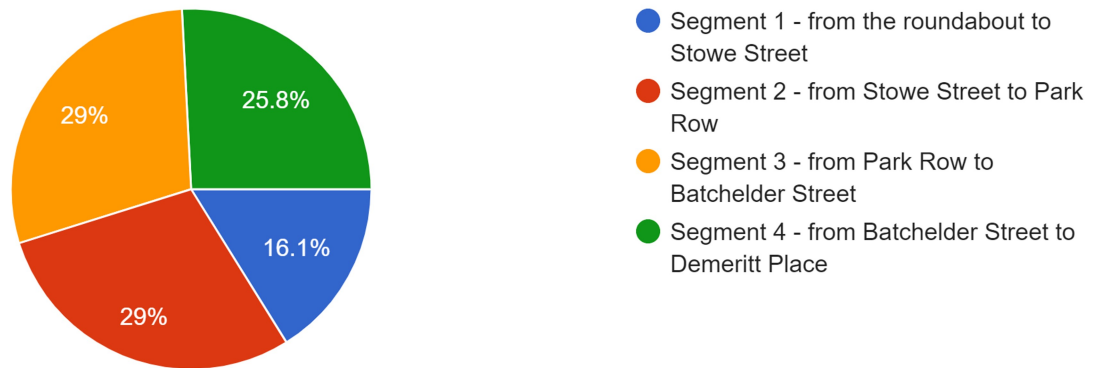
### Do you live in downtown Waterbury within the construction zone?

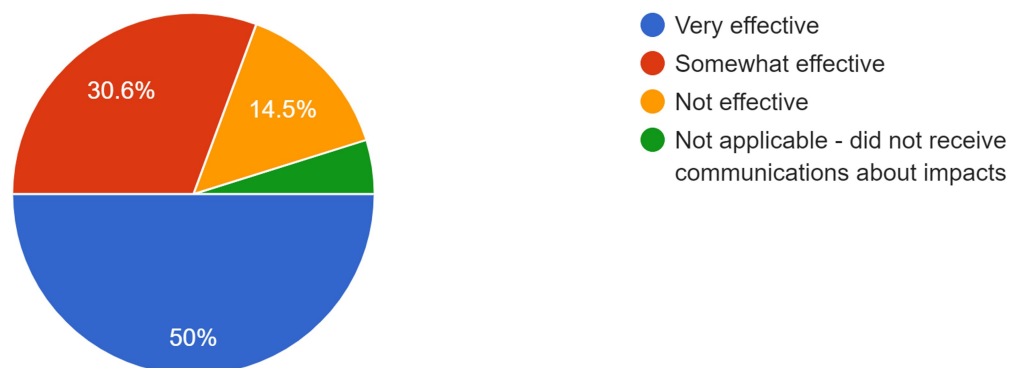
### In what segment is your home?

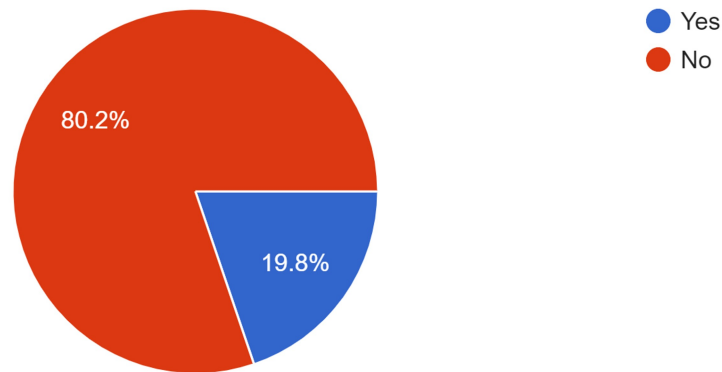
### How effective were the communications notifying you about impacts to your utilities, access to your home, or otherwise preparing you for construction activities?

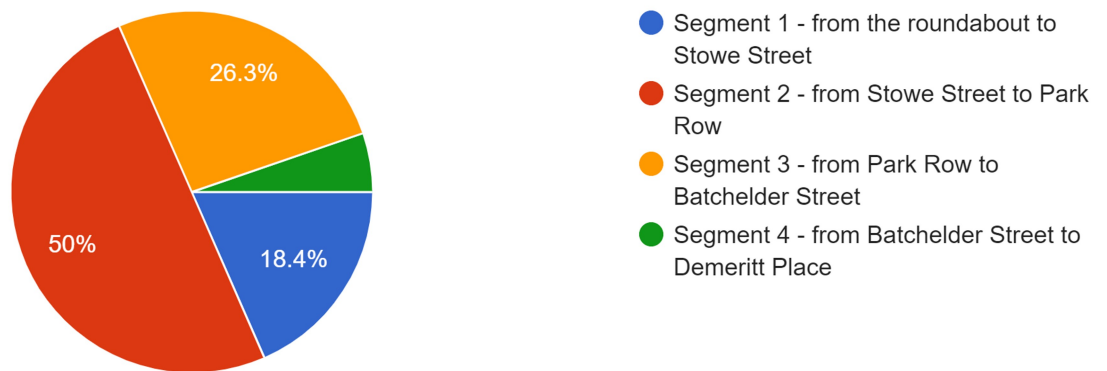
### Do you own a business in downtown Waterbury within the construction zone?

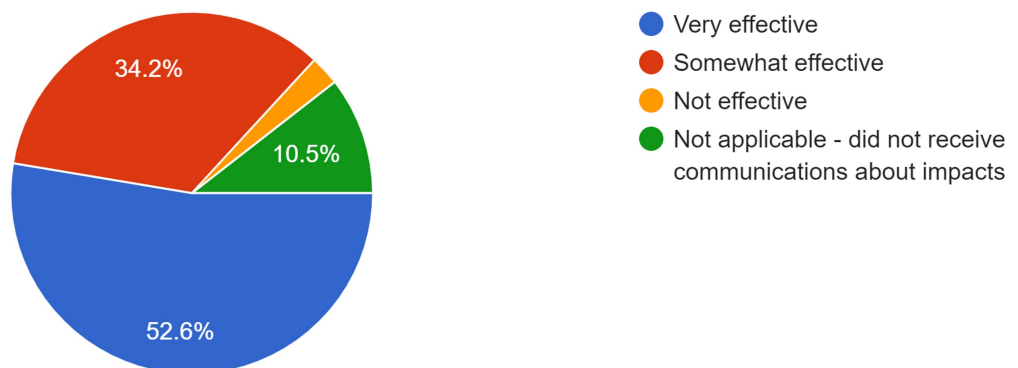
### In what segment is your business?

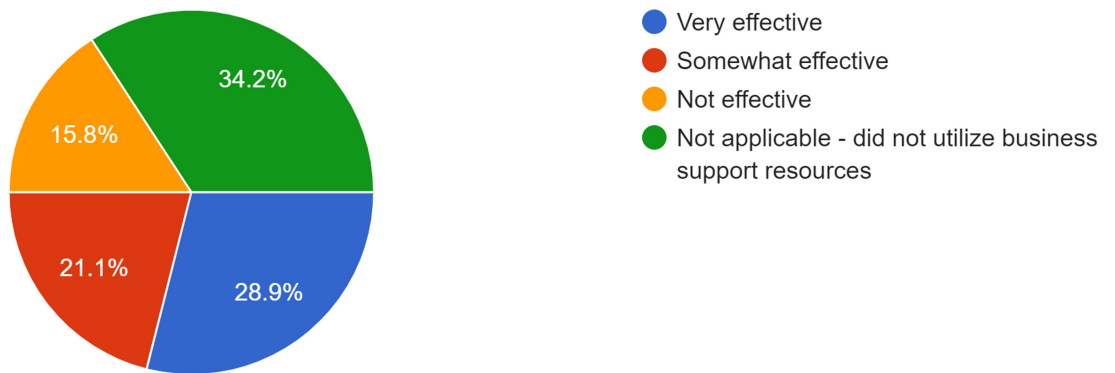


### How effective were the communications notifying you about impacts to your utilities, access to your business, or otherwise preparing you for construction activities?
