Survey Dates: Friday, December 4, 2020 - Monday, December 21, 2020

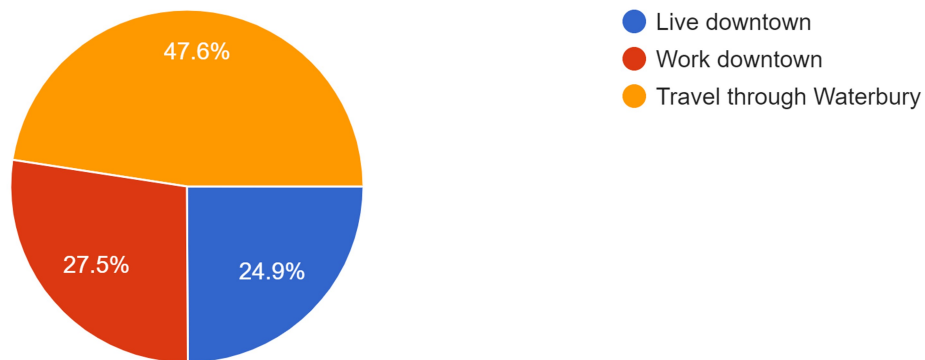
Total Respondents: 187

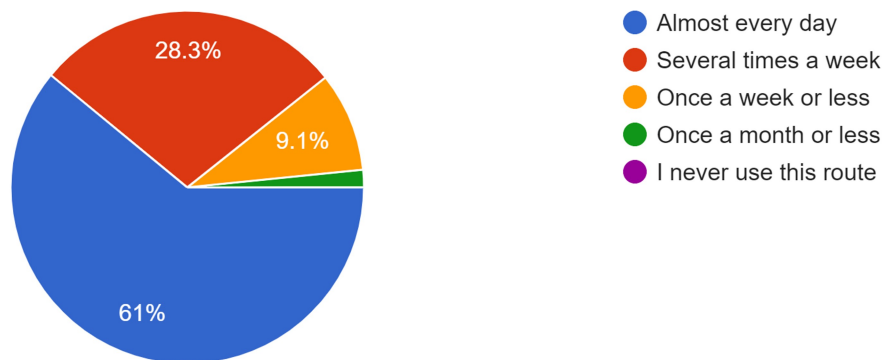
Do you live, work, or travel through downtown Waterbury? Select all that apply.

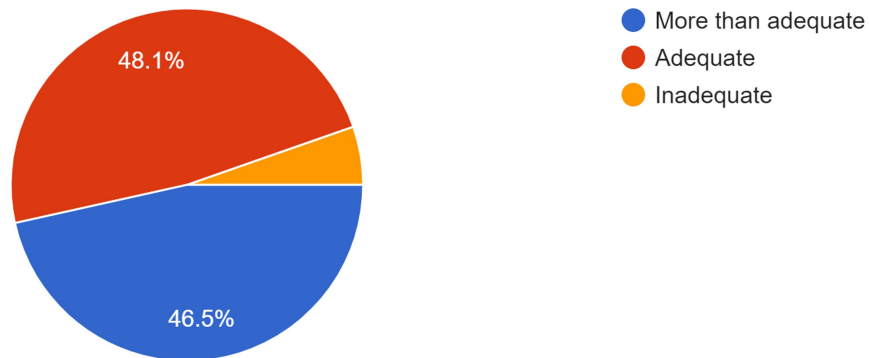
How often do you travel in downtown Waterbury?

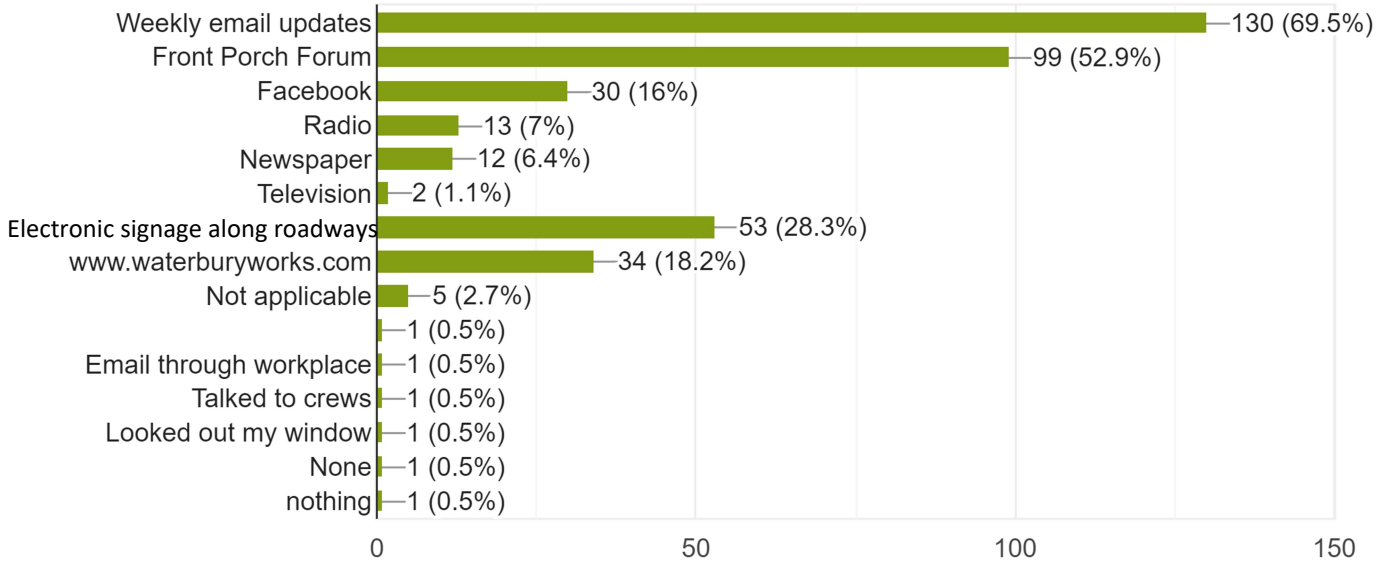
How would you rate the traffic control efforts (flaggers, signs, etc.) during the second year of the Main Street Reconstruction project?

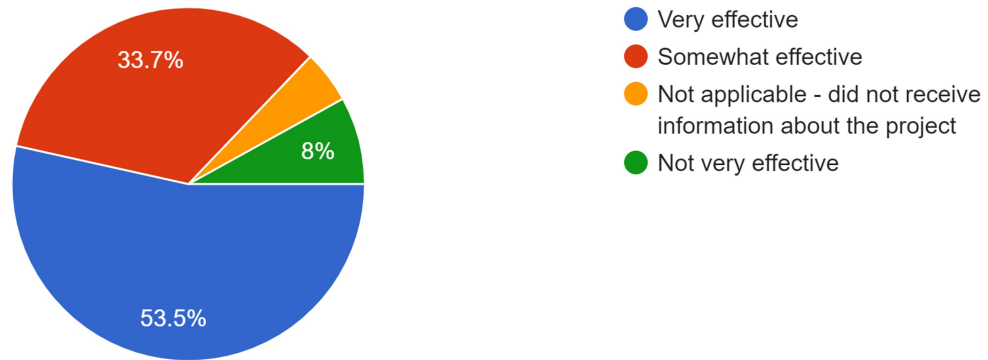
Which of the following sources of project information did you use? Select all that apply.

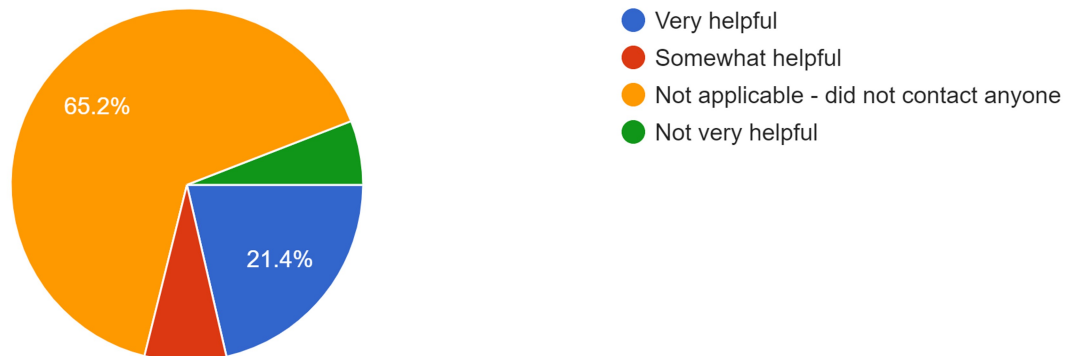
How effective were the construction updates in preparing you for construction activities and traffic conditions?

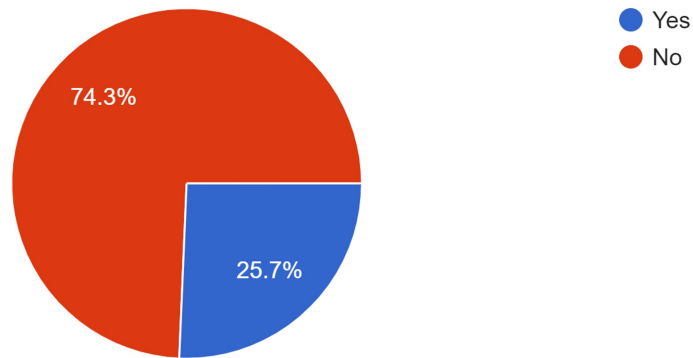

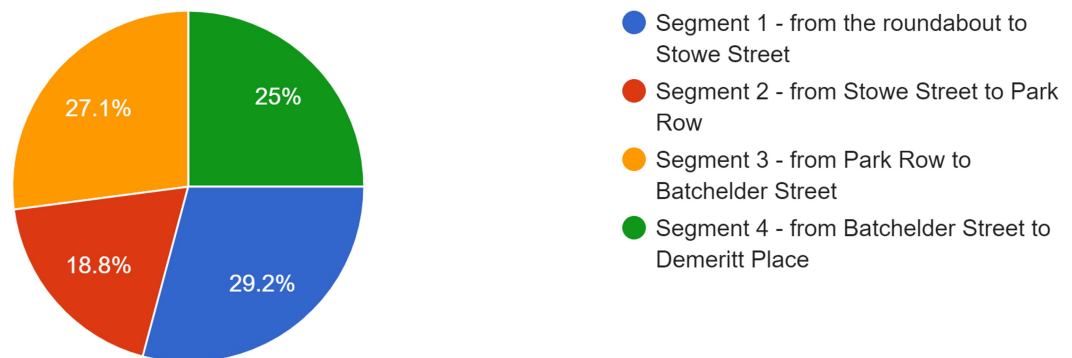
### Do you live in downtown Waterbury within the construction zone?

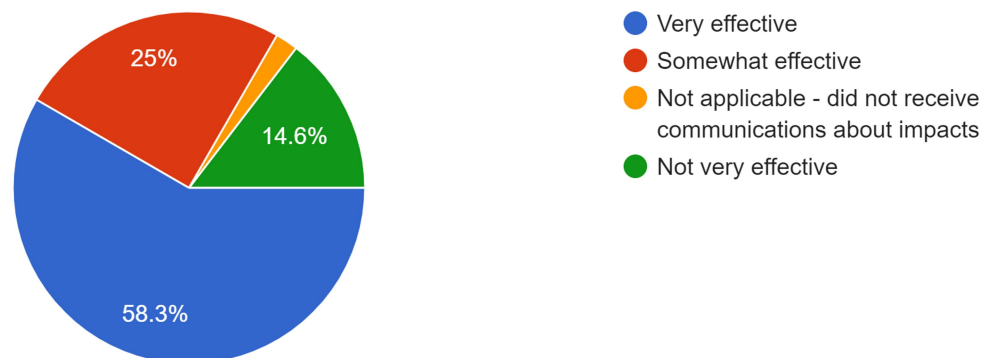
### In what segment is your home?

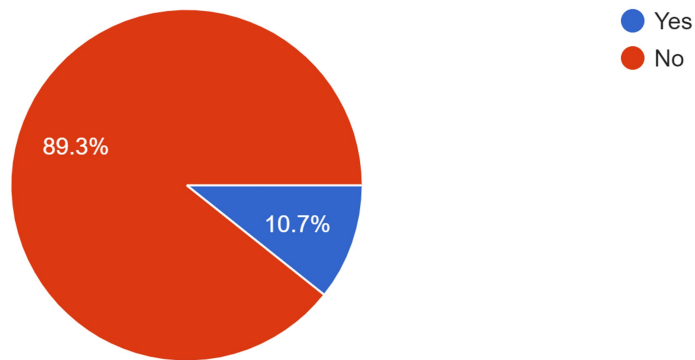
### How effective was the communication notifying you about construction-related impacts to your property, or otherwise preparing you for construction activities?

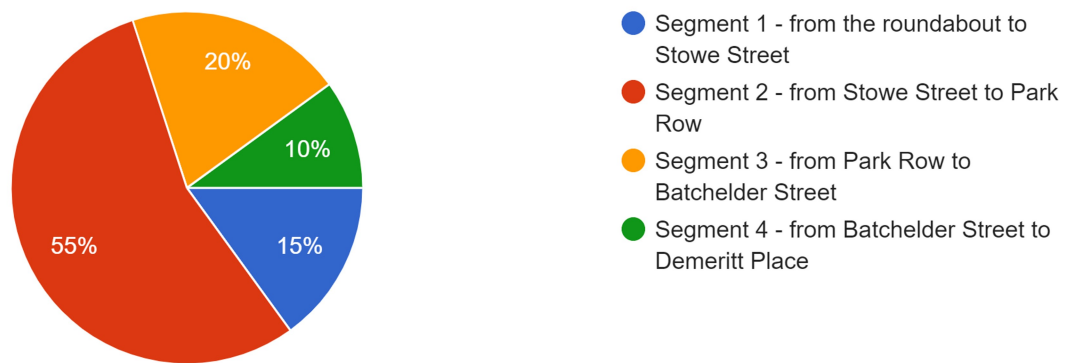
### Do you own a business in downtown Waterbury within the construction zone?

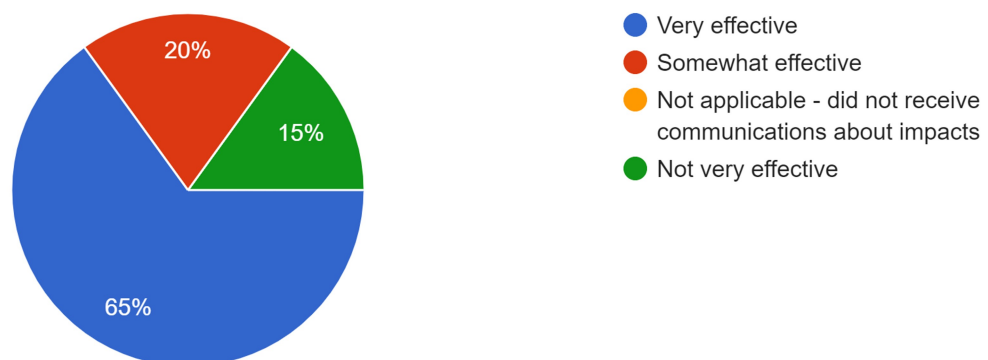
### In what segment is your business?

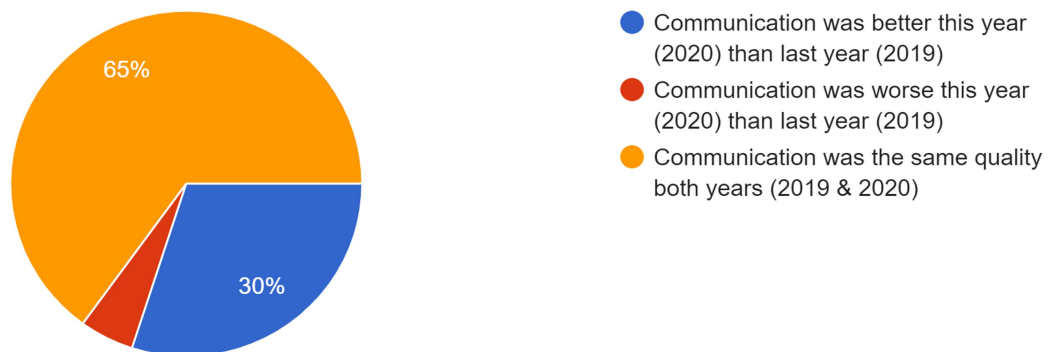

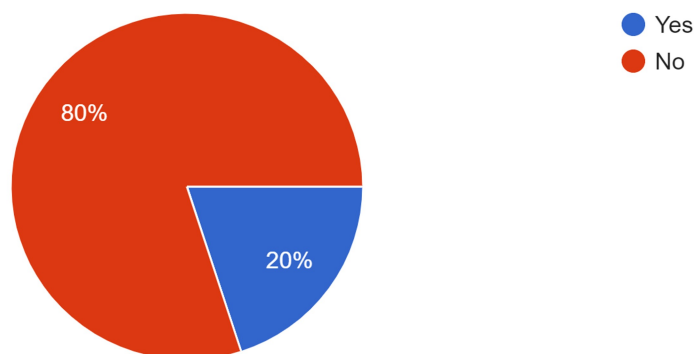
How did you feel that communications in 2020 regarding impacts and resources changed from 2019?
